ATTENTION TO DETAIL IS IMPORTANT WITH CRSB CERTIFICATION

The demand for CRSB beef is growing, but the supply isn't. This may be because mistakes are often made in the certification process

While cattle producers are enjoying rare times of record prices for their animals, costs are keeping pace with the market and skyrocketing. To be economically sustainable, finding every possible bonus is important.

One beef program that may be leaving money on the table is CRSB Certified. This could be because it is easy to miss small steps in the process, which may keep producers from accessing some payback.

While the Canadian Roundtable for Sustainable Beef's program for certifying beef has been around since 2017, there have been a few changes to be aware of.

WHAT IS CRSB CERTIFIED?

CRSB Certified is a third-party audited certification program aiming at building consumer confidence through a system of science-based checks along the supply chain. Since 2023, the Canadian Cattle Identification Agency has been the CRSB's approved live-cattle chain of custody verifier in Canada (excluding Quebec). It provides cattle supply chain tracking.

But that means everyone from farm gate to processing needs to be involved and do their part for the chain to remain unbroken — so the claims can be made, the CRSB Certified logo applied and the beef delivered to customers wanting the extra assurance.

It all starts at the grassroots. The first step is for farmers and ranchers to have their operations certified. Backgrounders and feedlots need to do that, too.

The majority of participating operations across Canada are certified to the CRSB's production standard by Verified Beef Production Plus, which is one of the CRSB's approved certification bodies for the program. The standard covers five areas of sustainability: natural resources, people and community, animal health and welfare, food, efficiency and innovation.

As of June 30, 2024, there were 1,300 CRSB Certified operations in Canada,

managing approximately 5.8 million acres of land across Canada.

If you've been certified with VBP+, you are also CRSB Certified through a single certification process. There is an annual check-in requirement and a full on-farm assessment is done every five years.

Certification can also be done by Where Food Comes From Inc., and Ontario feedlot operations can be certified by the Ontario Corn Fed Beef Quality Assurance Program.

WHAT'S THE PAYBACK?

To recognize the effort producers put in to become certified, there are some incentive programs.

The Cargill Qualifying Credit Payment started in 2018, provides a \$20 per head

credit for cattle that qualify all the way through, so Cargill can sell beef with the CRSB Certified claim to customers. The payment goes to each producer in the chain, but the animals must be harvested at Cargill.

Since 2023, a Certification Recognition Credit has been provided as a partnership between Cargill, its supply chain partners and the CRSB. It has provided up to \$400 to acknowledge producers who have been certified but were ultimately disqualified for other reasons. It serves as a top-up, both to send a demand signal and to help offset the basic costs of the process. The credit has been provided regardless of whether qualifying cattle were sold to Cargill.

“Between 2022 and 2024, Cargill paid out over \$4.2 million in direct producer payments under the two programs,” says Kristine Tapley, director of sustainability for Cargill Food North America.

Applications are now open again for the FCC's Sustainability Incentive Program, and the good news for FCC customers who are CRSB Certified is the amount available has doubled. The eligible maximum annual incentive payment per operation is now \$4,000, calculated as a portion of FCC lending.

“(This) is further recognition for producers who are adopting sustainable practices that contribute to a resilient food system in Canada,” says Don Badour, chair of the Certified Sustainable Beef Framework Canada. “As a beef producer myself, this increase in the total eligible incentive payment adds even more value to the CRSB certification program.”

WHAT'S THE MARKET SAYING?

It's a basic economic dilemma. Right now, there's more demand for CRSB Certified beef than there is supply.

“We have several customers that have a strong interest in CRSB Certified beef — some in purchasing more CRSB beef than they are able to today, as well as customers

who would like to be participating in the program but can't, because we just don't have that volume available," says Tapley.

"We want to make sure everybody gets all the incentives they can."

WHERE ARE THE GAPS?

There's no doubt the beef supply chain is a complex system. But if all the players come together, the certification process can be accomplished.

CRSB stakeholder relations director Andrea White believes closing a few information gaps across the chain could help fill some demand. It can be a matter of simple checks of four key steps:

- Get certified and maintain your certification. Complete the annual requirements specified by the program.
- Consent to sharing chain of custody information with CCIA and CRSB through your certification body. It's a simple step, easily overlooked. The information is only used to confirm certification status and track the cattle through the system. If the required consent's basic details are provided, contact information will appear in a section called "CRSB client information" in your Canadian Livestock Tracking System (CLTS) account. It's a good place to confirm you've completed that important step because if the consent is missing, the section won't appear at all.
- Cow-calf operators need to enter the birthdates of calves into their Canadian Livestock Tracking System account. Animals born within six months of certification are eligible for a certified supply chain.
- Any time cattle move to a new operation, the receiving party needs to enter move-in events into their Canadian Livestock Tracking System account. White says while everyone needs to confirm they have consented to share information, cow-calf producers only have to focus on birthdates, while backgrounders or feedlots are responsible for move-in data.

"If all certified operations that are 'active' (which means they've consented to sharing information), then the CCIA system can see those cattle moved from one certified cattle operation to the next, and those cattle will qualify — as long as they keep going through certified operations all the way and are harvested at Cargill," adds White.

CALL TO ACTION

When it comes to responsibilities along the chain, it's about teamwork.

"To be honest, on my side, I'm just doing everything I can to make sure I'm not the weak link," says Brodie Haugan, a fourth-generation rancher in southern Alberta and CRSB council member.

"As cattle progress that we're either owning, or buying and selling, you just need to make sure that you've done your part in the chain. I'd like to think that if you do your part, the next person does their part."

After spending a decade with the Alberta Beef Producers as a delegate and a term as chair, Haugan has heard hesitation about getting certified. But as a producer, he knows it is not as complicated as it seems.

"To me, other than a little bit more management work on the bookkeeping and paperwork side of things, we have had to change very little. The things that we have changed are beneficial management practices — things that we didn't think of before."

TIPS?

White says it's important to keep the information flowing, like making sure your selling agent knows the cattle are CRSB Certified and shares the message. Also,

include your CRSB certificate number on any sale paperwork or manifest.

White encourages feedlots to look for qualified calves when sourcing, to address the demand at every stage.

There is a CRSB search tool in CCIA's Canadian Livestock Tracking System that allows participants to view the CRSB certification status of a specific animal in real time via tag or indicator number, which shows full or partial qualification through the chain.

There is also opportunity for producers to connect with or establish a relationship with feedlots who are part of this process.

"It's in everybody's interest, not only to connect those dots with the selling of the cattle but then making sure everyone is aware of the requirements," White says. "Ensuring loops are closed can be as simple as individuals checking with each other. Everybody talking with each other can ensure the chain is complete."

THE BIG PICTURE

While the financial bonuses are significant, there's a more substantial sustainability piece as well.

"If the only reason you're doing the program is hoping you'll get another five cents, I don't think you're doing the program for the right reasons," says Haugan.

Tapley sees opportunity in the industry based on the growing demand for CRSB Certified beef.

"More and more customers are making sure that there is rigour and standards behind where they are sourcing their products, and that is not going away," says Tapley.

"If you think about what has been created — a sustainable sourcing framework that has a (verified) chain of custody all the way through — and if you compare it to other sustainability systems around the globe, it's really impressive. The Canadian beef industry should be proud of the progress that has been made so far."

Haugan, who is now on the Canadian Cattle Association executive, says he is proud of the beef industry in Canada and the growing focus on sustainability.

"We do have one of the best products in the world," he says. "This is one of the programs that does help support that claim and the work we do within the industry across Canada." 🍁

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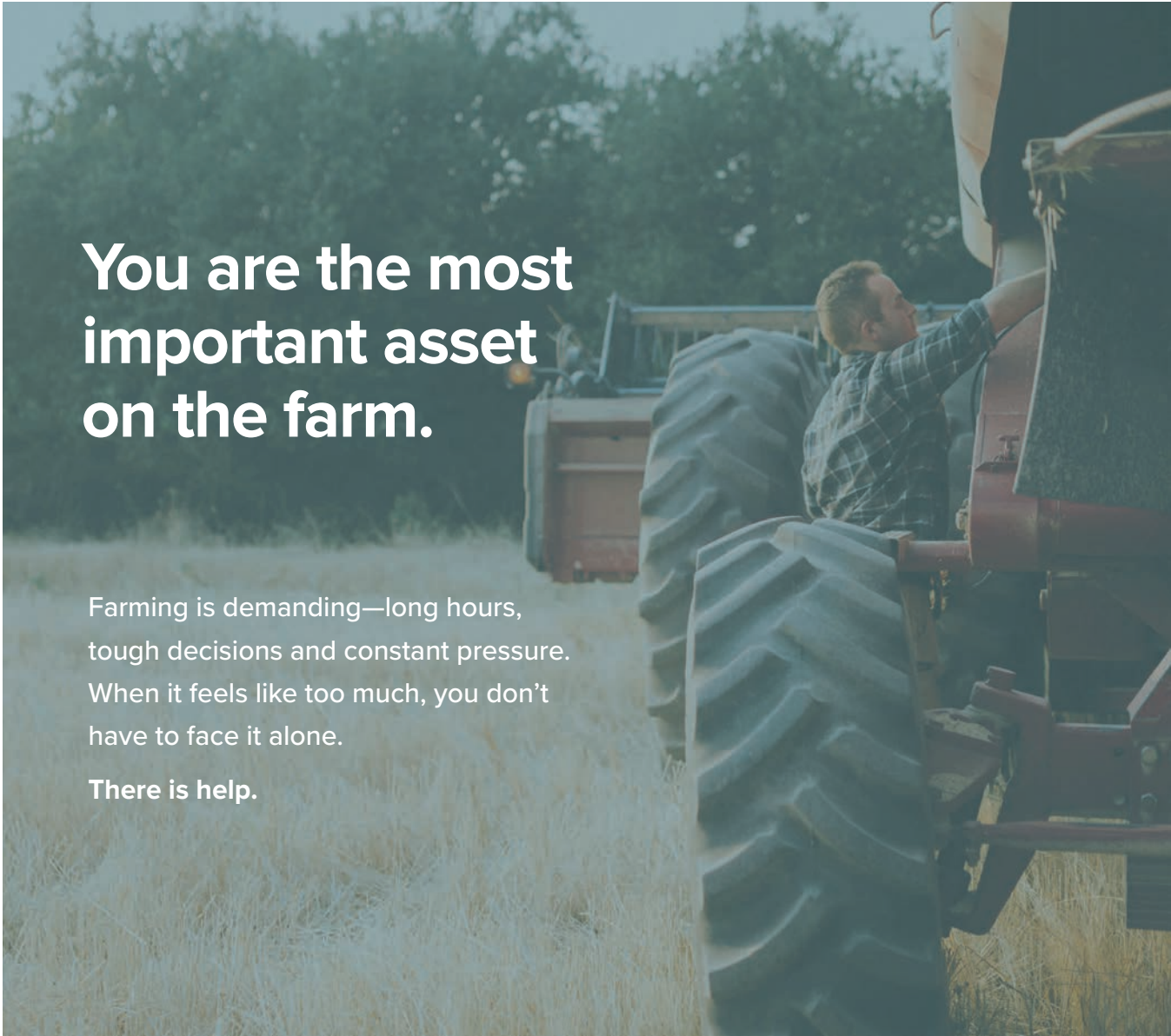
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Movement Matters

Client participation

The movement record function in the Canadian Livestock Tracking System (CLTS) is available for use ahead of regulatory amendments. CCIA has added features to the CLTS movement reporting model to ease the administrative burden of our clients. We encourage clients to participate by reporting livestock movements in the CLTS and sharing feedback on this feature.

The regulatory amendments will focus on the identification and registration of premises where livestock are kept or collected, the identification of livestock, and the domestic movement reporting of livestock. Using the movement record in the CLTS strengthens traceability and supports communication between producers, transporters and destinations. This leads to faster identification and notification of stakeholders during a disease outbreak. Log in and check it out!

CLTS movement record

A movement record is initiated by the producer, all parties (producer, transporter, and destination) enter their data, and the destination submits the movement information.

Currently the movement feature is not a regulatory requirement, although it meets the proposed regulations and is a step towards more effective traceability.

Group movements

The Group Move-In/Move-Out feature allows movement reporting without listing individual tag numbers, but is only available for assembly points such as auction marts or assembly yards.

Auction marts and assembly yards are not required to report tag numbers—but must include the total number of animals and species.

Feedlots and other sites must report tag IDs in the Move-In event.
